OUR REDEEMER'S LUTHERAN CHURCH **THE VOICE**

What does the Our Redeemer's Council do?

Way back in July (remember summer?), I wrote about the mechanics of populating and maintaining the church Council. I also promised to provide more information about the Council's functions and duties.

However, before getting into the specifics of our Council, it may be helpful to take a step back and consider the bigger picture. The ELCA's Model Constitution for Congregations, which forms the basis for Our Redeemer's constitution, is a good source for that perspective. It describes our fundamental purpose as "responding in faith to the call of the Holy Spirit through the Gospel ... to unite together to preach the Word, administer the sacraments, and carry out God's mission ... "

The Model Constitution establishes the ultimate organization of the Church (with a capital 'C', as in the universal body of Christ) by affirming that "All power in the Church belongs to our Lord Jesus Christ, its head. All actions of this congregation are to be carried out under his rule and authority." The relationship between the universal Church and individual congregations is described by observing that "Congregations find their fulfillment in the universal community of the Church, and the universal Church exists in and through congregations."

The Model Constitution characterizes the purpose of the Church this way: "The Church is a people created by God in Christ, empowered by the Holy Spirit, called and sent to bear witness to God's creative, redeeming, and sanctifying activity in the world." As an ELCA congregation, we participate in this mission by worshiping God in a triune manner: 1) proclaiming the gospel, 2) administering the sacraments, and 3) living lives of prayer, praise, thanksgiving, witness, and service. To do this, we commit to the following list of actions:

- Provide services of worship at which the Word of God is preached, and the sacraments are administered.
- Provide pastoral care and assist all members to participate in this ministry.
- Challenge, equip, and support all members in carrying out their calling in their daily lives and in their congregation.
- Teach the Word of God.
- Witness to the reconciling Word of God in Christ, reaching out to all people.
- Respond to human needs, work for justice and peace, care for the sick and the suffering, and participate responsibly in society.
- expressions of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America.
- organization of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America.
- Foster and participate in ecumenical relationships consistent with churchwide policy.

I find all of this pretty exciting, but I can understand if that's not true for you. After all, they're just a bunch of words. It's like a written piece of music—just a lot of dots and lines and squiggles on paper until ... a group of talented musicians brings it to life by giving it breath, rhythm, harmony, and emotion. Our challenge, as a part of the Body of Christ within the ELCA, is to turn these aspirational words into growth, compassion, healing, and new life in God! As a Council member, you will get a unique view of the many ways our members routinely meet that challenge. And you'll have an opportunity to apply your own gifts and experiences to support God's work in this congregation and in this world.

The next Council term will begin early next year. Please prayerfully consider whether God might be calling you to this ministry of leadership. 


GRIEF SUPPORT GROUP



Financial Review

General Receipts for the Ministry Fund totaled \$34,429 for August which was \$2,247 less than August 2023. However, our annual giving is \$4,933 ahead of expenses, a rarity at the end of the summer months. Building Fund donations for August totaled \$6,238 which was \$1,644 less than August 2023 and \$4,665 less than the monthly mortgage payment. The Council agreed to delay transferring August designated funds and the monthly gift to the Montana Synod.

Ministry Reports

Staff reports centered on preparation for fall programming, including Sunday School, Confirmation and Youth Group. There will be retreats for both middle and high school students this fall.

The new sound system is installed and reviews from both our in person and online are very positive. John Hermanson will join us for a concert on Sunday, October 7 to celebrate this upgrade to our worship experience.

Lori Walter's title will change from Administrative Assistant to Office Manager to more accurately reflect the work she does.

The Council expressed continuing appreciation for the work of the Call Committee as we search for an Associate Pastor. There was significant discussion regarding pastoral work load, including some concrete suggestions for short term assistance that our president and treasurer will be exploring.

Committee Reports

Personnel Committee — The committee has prepared a draft revised policy manual for preliminary review. Ingrid and Pastor Trina will review.

Stewardship Committee — Discussed upcoming work day (September 28) and results of the sound system campaign.

Property Development — Continuing to coordinate with RMDC and proceeding with a preapplication for an Administrative Minor subdivision.

Unfinished Business

• Building and Property Use Policy — A committee has met and is close to finishing a draft policy update.

• 2023 Audit — The Audit Committee has been formed and will begin their week in the next couple weeks.



Remember to celebrate with us on Sunday, October 13, when we present THE BIG CHECK to Helena Food Share at both worship services.


UPCOMING ADULT EDUCATION OPPORTUNITIES

Lori is often the first person to greet a newcomer or visitor. She has a warm smile and a gentle voice on the phone. During the workday, Lori often works with callers, emails, and personal visits by members, many simultaneously. Still, with great compassion, she provides a listening ministry and takes confidentiality very seriously.


